## Pre-Conference Workshop – ‘An introduction to multilevel models’

Led by Professor Harvey Goldstein, University of Bristol, UK - Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> September – 13:00 hrs

Multilevel modelling is now a standard technique in use throughout social science research. This half-day workshop will explain how multilevel models can be used in longitudinal research with examples. The workshop will avoid undue technicalities and will demonstrate the use of software. Topics will include ‘growth studies’, ‘school choice research’ and ‘survival/event history models’. Time will be provided to allow participants to raise their own research problems.
